The following materials are accepted from Howard County residents:

Antifreeze

Please leave container for attendant to empty. Do NOT empty container yourself.

Bicycles

Reusable bicycles only. No tricycles or motorized bikes.

Cardboard

Please flatten. Not Styrofoam or plastic packaging.

Clothing & Textiles

Clothing, curtains, sheets, blankets, towels, hats, belts, handbags, paired shoes.

Compressed Gas Tanks

Fire extinguishers, propane, helium & oxygen tanks.

Cooking Oil

Used cooking oil.

Electronics

Anything with a plug that is not an appliance or furniture.

Flags

Old and worn U.S. flags for retirement by the American Legion.

Food Scraps

If bagged must use compostable bags.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Paint, gasoline, rechargeable (lithium or button) batteries, pesticides, insecticides, solvents, furniture strippers, degreasers, CFLs, etc.

Open April-November, Saturdays only. Check our website for winter dates.

Mattresses & Box Springs

Dry mattresses & box springs. 100% soft foam mattresses. Please load vertically.

Metal Items

Appliances, furnaces, air conditioners, auto parts, furniture, mowers, copper and brass items, aluminum siding, tire chains, light fixtures, tire rims, fencing, cable, etc. Drain motors of oil and fuel.

Note: Place air conditioners and refrigerators in designated area. Freon removal fee applies to commercial businesses.

Oil & Filters

Motor oil, transmission oil and oil filters.

Oyster & Clam Shells

Empty shells are cleaned, reseeded and returned to the Bay.

Reusable Household Items

Goodwill is located by the gazebo every Monday and the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month and accepts gently used clothes, toys, books, furniture and household items.

Reusable Building Materials

Banisters, bathtubs, cabinets, countertops, doors, hardware, lighting fixtures, lumber, molding, plumbing fixtures, shelving, stairs, toilets, windows, etc. Donations go to The Loading Dock. Tax receipts are available on the first Saturday of the month.

Rigid Plastics

Buckets, lawn furniture, laundry baskets, flower pots, garbage cans, etc. No PVC pipes, tubing, vinyl siding.

Roofing Shingles

Paper and nails may be mixed with roofing shingles. Tipping fee applies. NO trash, wood or miscellaneous items.

Single Stream

Paper, plastic bottles and containers, metal food & drink cans, aluminum foil, glass bottles and jars. Containers must be empty. Leave lids, labels, and caps on.

Styrofoam #6

White foam packaging, clean food trays, cups, containers, and egg cartons (all colors). Items must be foam marked with #6. NO foam peanuts, foam insulation, clamshells or other non-foam #6 containers.

Tires

Automobile & truck tires. Limit 4 tires annually. NO rims.

Trash

Last Resort! Non-donatable, unrepairable, non-recyclable items only.

Wet Cell Batteries

Auto, boat and motorcycle. (Rechargeable and other non-alkaline batteries are accepted as HHW). Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in your regular trash.

Wood and Yard Trimmings

Brush, Christmas trees, stumps, grass, leaves, pallets, untreated lumber, etc. Plastic bags are prohibited.

Prohibited Items

- Ammunition
- Friable AsbestosMedical Waste
- Dead Animals
- Radioactive Waste

Hot AshExplosives

- Septic Waste
- Engine blocks (over 2')
